Entries Close: Monday, July 23th, ONLINE ONLY

Tuesday, August 21, at 8:00am - 10:30 pm

Livestock Released: Sunday, August 26th, 7 pm

Rules:

1. Pre entry is required online.
2. Animals entered will be required to stay on grounds the entire Fair week as required by the junior departments, please see all junior departments for requirements.
3. Poultry must arrive Tuesday, August 21st, between 3 – 5pm for health check.
3. Primary showmanship projects are for youth between 5 and 8 years of age (Kindergarten to 3rd grade). Members shall not have passed their 9th birthday by December 31st of the current year. Primary members are eligible to show poultry, pygmy goat, Nigerian Dwarf goat and rabbit.
4. There will be only showmanship. Participation ribbons only. No cash awards no entry fees.
5. Exhibitors must care for the animal for at least 60 days prior for goats and 30 days prior for poultry and rabbits. Animal does not have to be owned by the 4-her, but must be in the care of the exhibitor.
6. Primary projects are designed to be a cooperative projects involving the whole family. They are not to be a competitive breeding or market project.
7. State and Local Rules apply. Please check with 4-H for official uniform requirements.
